- The fast rate of new technology development makes it almost impossible to keep up, including the current surge of artificial intelligence (AI) software and tools.
- Hence, it is essential to redesign librarian competency by focusing on upskilling and reskilling.
- This should be a top priority to ensure that librarians are prepared for the future and their profession remains relevant and resilient.
